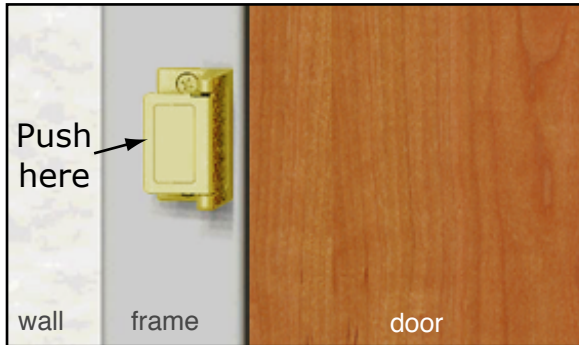

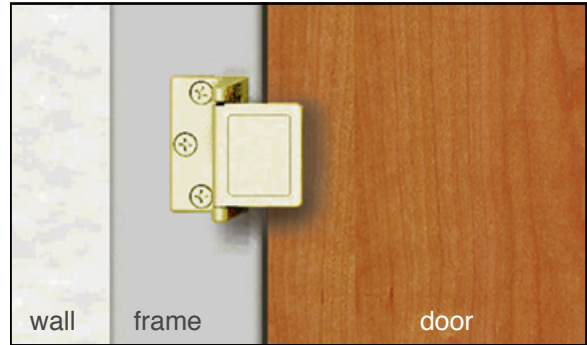

Magnet holds "SAL" in locked position.  
Prevents door from opening.

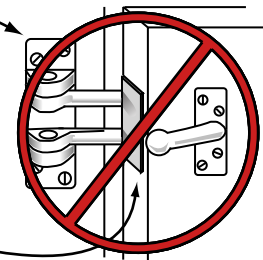


"Touch release"™ to disengage magnet.
